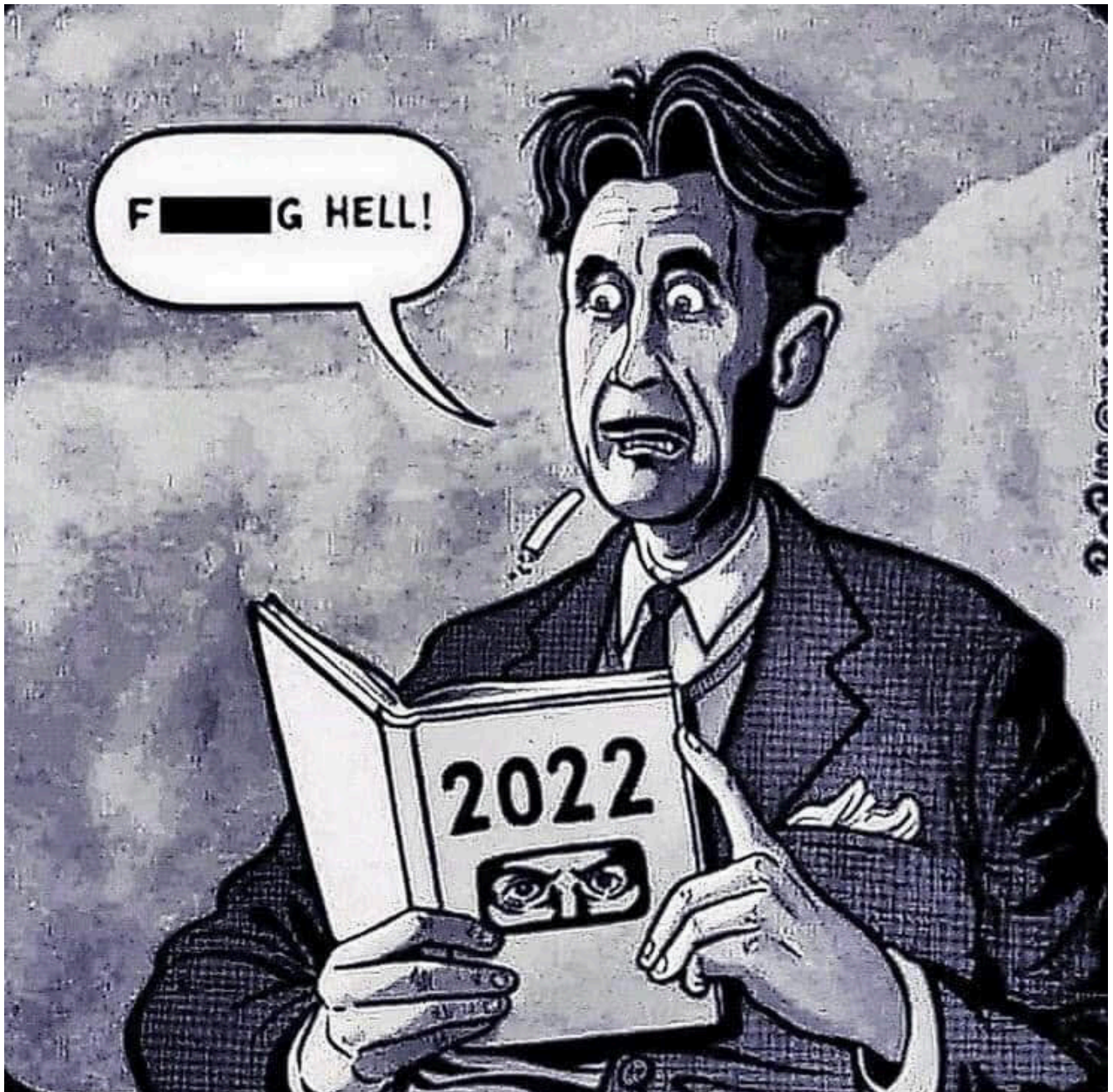


Words of Wisdom



George Orwell, author of 1984

Since I was a teenager, I've been influenced by some of the greatest scientists, philosophers, theorists, thinkers, artists and yes, comedians. Their thoughts and their morals have been a catechism for my life, a kind of rule book which has made my existence on this planet more bearable, even inspiring. Over the years I wrote them down in a notebook and I've reproduced them here so that my children might benefit from their wisdom.

Words of Wisdom

Joseph Stalin once ripped all the feathers of a live chicken. Then he put the chicken, bloodied and suffering, down on the floor a few paces away. Then he started throwing some grains of wheat on the ground and the chicken started following him around. Stalin said *“this is how easy it is to govern stupid people — they will follow you no matter how much pain you cause them as long as you throw them a little worthless rest once in a while.”*

Psychologist Stanley Milgram proved that 80% of the population did not have the psychological or moral resources to defy an authority’s order, no matter how illegitimate the order was. Therefore, only the remaining 20% have the ability to think critically, to determine right from wrong... and that is not enough.

This is how we are conditioned, manipulated and programmed by governments and wealthy special interest groups with multiple agendas:

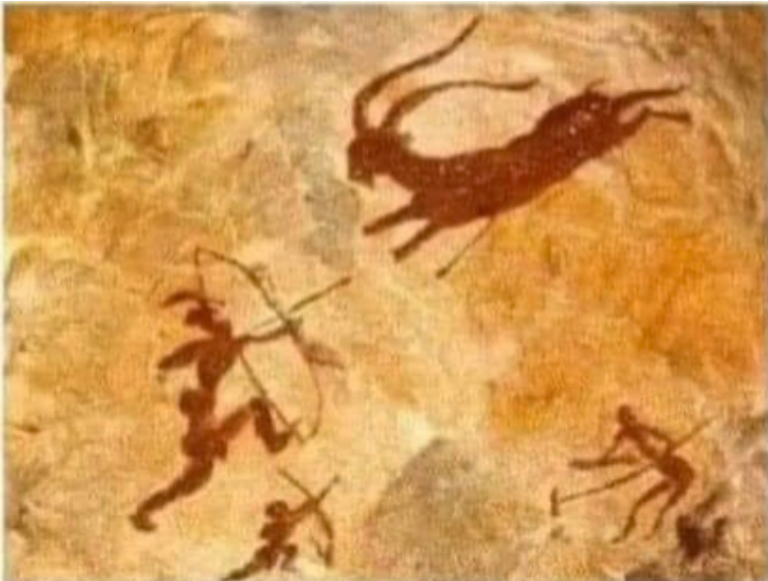
